

E.N.C.A.O.A. Announces High School Volleyball Clinics

The Eastern North Carolina Athletic Officials Association (E.N.C.A.O.A.) announces the start of its 2017 Volleyball Clinics and NCHSAA State Clinics. Local clinics will be held at Hunt High School, North Carolina Wesleyan College, Roanoke Rapids High School, and the Alice F. Keene District Park in Greenville.

The ENCAOA is seeking new officials willing to complete the eligibility requirements.

The E.N.C.A.O.A. will host a NCHSAA State Clinic on Monday, June 26, at the Wilson County Agriculture Center, 1806 South Goldsboro Street in Wilson. Local clinics start Tuesday, June 27, at Alice F. Keene District Park.

Officials are required to attend 6 local clinics, 1 NCHSAA State Clinic, and work 8 hours of scrimmages. Officials must register with the NCHSAA by June 15 to be eligible to officiate NCHSAA games.
