

W.C.Y.A.A.'s 10U Win District Tournament

The Wilson County Youth Athletic Association's 10U Baseball All-Stars rolled thru the 2013 E.N.C. District Four Tournament in Snow Hill with a 3-0 record after ripping the Wayne County All-Stars 11-0. Gavin Huff pitched a four inning no-hitter. He struck out nine Wayne County batters and allowed one walk. Huff was over powering from start to finish for the Wilson County All-Stars.

Wilson County blew the game open in the bottom of the first inning by scoring seven runs. Caleb Lamm and Tristan Little singled to start the game. After a fielder's choice, Tyler Godwin tripled to score both runners. Tyler Pegram walked and then Godwin scored on an error by the shortstop. After Ryan Barnes followed with another walk Joshua Siemons ripped a single up the middle scoring Pegram and Travis Davis. Dylan Harrelson drew a walk before Lamm got his second hit of the inning, a two run single.

In the second inning, Huff led off with a triple and scored on a Davis single to push the lead to 8-0. Wilson County wrapped up the win with three runs in the top of the fourth on Lamm's double and singles by Little, Godwin, and a tow run single by Pegram.

Wilson County now advances to the 2013 E.N.C. State Tournament in Southern Pines, N.C., July 11. The All-Stars will play their first game versus West Raleigh at 11:00am in the double elimination tournament.
